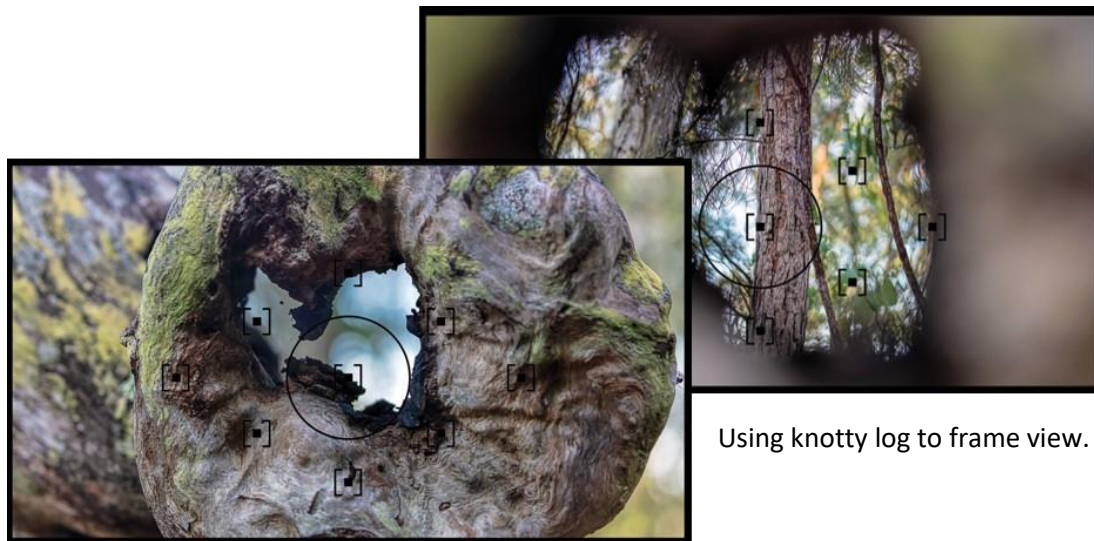
What Aspect and Viewpoint best tells your story?

You, the photographer, control subject selection, isolation, lighting, perspective and camera controls to create your spectacular visual story.

Aspect at its basic is landscape vs portrait vs square vs panorama.

Viewpoint is the creative use of position to frame your photos, for example, emphasise the majesty of a tree by getting low and shooting up, or use a found object to frame your view to draw attention to a particular feature.

We will start by running through some camera basics (controls, modes, settings) before exploring how to use camera settings to isolate close-up subjects and get the most from lighting and angles.

Then we put it into practice exploring Mt Gravatt Conservation Reserve to find your story to share with the group.

Bring your camera: either basic point and shoot OR digital SLR - the key ingredient is you.

Bring a tripod if possible and a small torch for lighting subjects.

Wear enclosed shoes and clothing suitable for walking in the bush.
